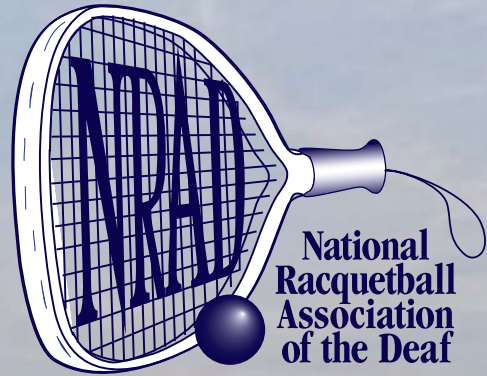

# TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. All matches (singles and doubles) are double-elimination format.
2. Player must check in with tournament desk 15 minutes prior to start time. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of match.
3. Tournament director has the right to deny or reclassify any entrant. Proof may be requested for any age division.
4. Divisions may be combined or eliminated if there are not enough entrants.
5. Modified USRA rules. Matches will be 2 games to 15 points, tie-breaker to 11 points. All games are won by one point.
6. **Lensed Eyewear** manufactured for racquet sports is **MANDATORY** in all events or violators will **FORFEIT** their match.
7. All winners will be required to referee. Failure to referee will result in forfeit of the next match. It is your responsibility to find a qualified substitute.

## Entry Deadline

Entries must be postmarked on or before April 15, 2007. Deadline for late entries must be on or before April 24 and must include a \$10 late fee. Faxed entries will be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director: call VP/TTY 845-623-3947. There will be **NO REFUNDS**.

## Eligibility

An athlete shall have a hearing loss of 55 dB or greater in both or the better ear to compete in the NRAD tournament.

### Note: Doubles Rules for Men's, Women's and Mixed Events

**GROUP 1: Open** Players may choose **Open, A, B, C,** or **Novice** player

**GROUP 2: A** player may choose **A** or **B** player or **B** player choose another **B** player

**GROUP 3: C** player may choose **C** or **Novice** Players or **Novice** Players choose another **Novice** player

A change in playing partners may be made so long as the first match of the posted team has not begun. For this purpose only, the match will be considered started once the teams have been called to the court. The team must notify the tournament director of any changes prior to the beginning of the match.
